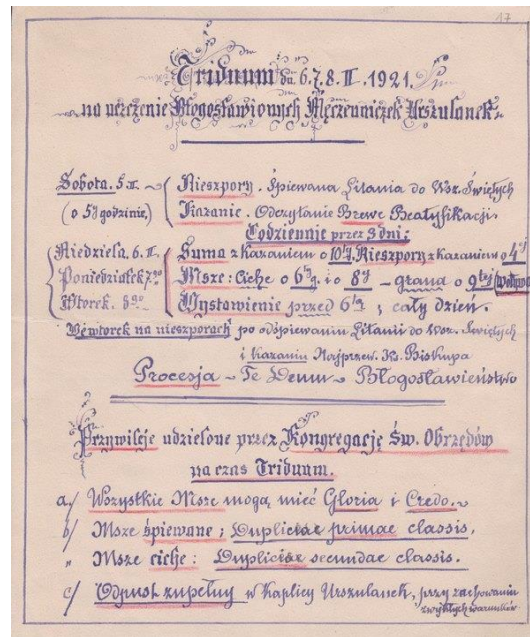


Triduum on November 6,7,8, 1921
In honor of the Blessed Ursuline Martyrs
In Krakow (Poland)



Saturday, November 5 : Vespers, singing of the Litany of the Saints

(at 5 P.M.) Sermon, Brief Reading of the Beatification

Each day of the Triduum:

Sunday, 6: 10 A.M.: Solemn Mass with sermon. Vespers with sermon at 4 P.M.

Monday 7: at 6 and 8 A.M.: Mass without singing.

: at 9 A.M.: sung Mass (literally « played »); (a votive Mass).

Tuesday 8: from 6 A.M. on: Exposition of the Blessed Sacrament, during the whole day.

Wednesday 9: at Vespers, after the singing of the Litanies of the Blessed Sacrament and our Bishop's Sermon : procession, *Te Deum*, blessing.

Privileges granted by the Sacred Congregation for the time of the Triduum

a/ At all Masses, the Gloria and Credo can be recited.

b/ Sung Masses : double of the 1st class.

Masses without singing: double of the 2nd class.

c/ A plenary indulgence in the chapel of the Ursulines, according to the usual conditions.
